IN 2024, OUR WATER PROGRAMS IMPACTED

589,630 people

Access to clean water is essential to life and a basic human right, yet almost 2 billion people experience absolute water scarcity worldwide. Humaniti and our partners are using modern technology and innovative solutions to restore clean water sources and expand access faster than ever before.

HOW WE'RE IMPACTING

Wells and tap stands

Repairing and installing systems that extract and produce clean water from the ground.

Atmospheric water generators

An innovative system that turns vapour from the air into a sustainable source of clean water.

Solar water boxes

Self-contained, portable water sources that yield 10,000 litres a day for up to 25 years





HOW CLEAN WATER CHANGES LIVES

Clean water access helps vulnerable populations immediately and over time

It reduces disease, improves health, and lowers child mortality. Hygiene and sanitation also improve.

Long-term, it boosts economic stability by supporting education and productivity. Women and girls gain opportunities as they spend less time collecting water.

WHO WE'RE IMPACTING

Our water programs quenched thirst and replenished hope for people in **Pakistan, Yemen,** and for Syrian refugees in **Turkiye.**



FOOD

IN 2024, OUR SHARE A MEAL PROGRAMS IMPACTED

341,690 people

Over 2 billion people are food insecure and malnutrition is one of the greatest threats to human life, despite the world producing more than enough food for everyone. Humaniti and our partners are tackling the global food crisis with a unique set of solutions to improve food security around the world.

HOW WE'RE IMPACTING

Hot meals

Delivering immediate comfort and nourishment

Food packs

Weeks or months' worth of nutritious food supplies including meat and vegetables

Ramadan meals

Nourishing families through the holy month with Iftar meals

Food trucks

Providing thousands of food items for years to come

School meal programs

Providing schools with daily meals for up to a year or more.

Staple supplies

Supporting households with essential food items that have many different culinary uses

Qurbani

Providing weeks or months' worth of protein-rich nourishment through Qurbani rations





HOW NUTRITIOUS FOOD CHANGES LIVES

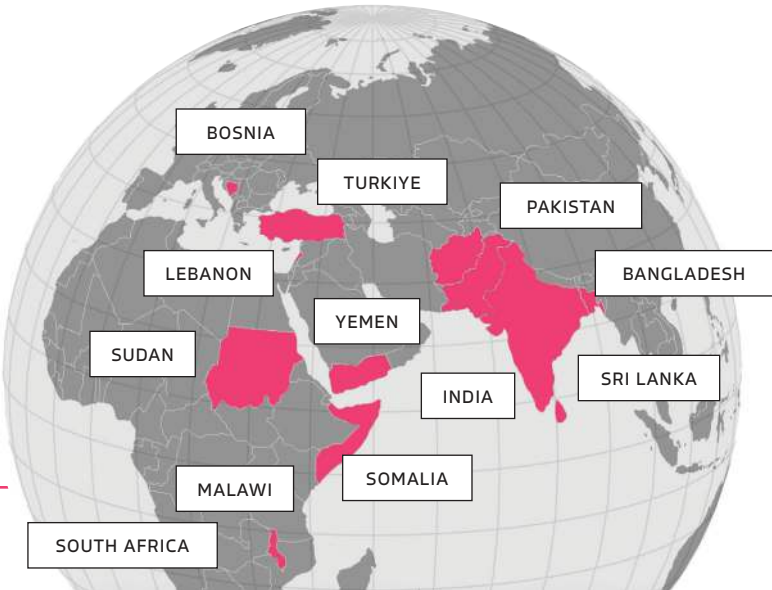
Nutritious food provides essential short-term and long-term benefits.

In the short term, it prevents hunger, boosts energy, and strengthens immunity. Children focus better in school, and adults stay productive.

Long term, it supports growth, reduces chronic disease risk, and enhances cognitive function. This leads to better education, economic opportunities, and healthier communities, breaking the cycle of poverty.

Climate and conflict put millions of people in a state of immediate desperation and fear for their lives. Humaniti and our partners are working to build the largest network for emergency relief, employing new and unique approaches to delivering urgent aid.

HOW EMERGENCY RELIEF CHANGES LIVES

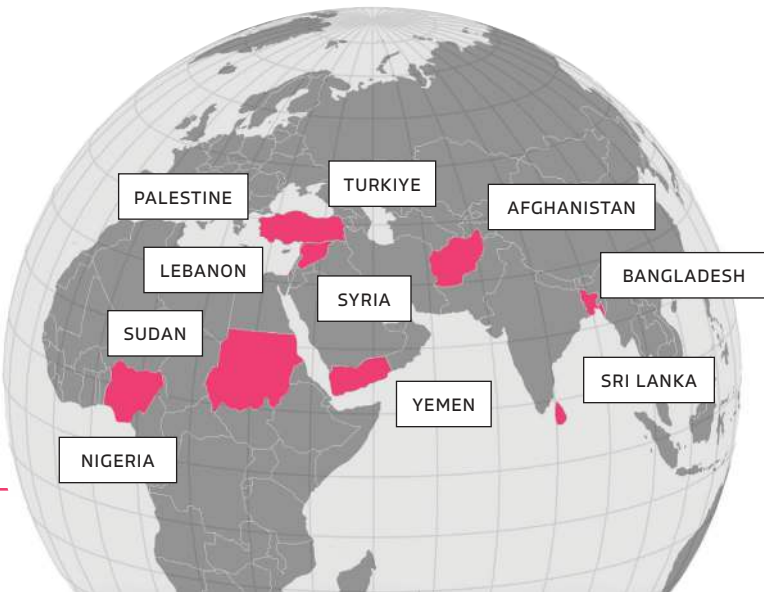
Emergency aid provides immediate relief by offering food, water, shelter, and medical care during crises, saving lives and reducing suffering.

Beyond the immediate benefits, this type of support helps rebuild communities, restore stability, and support recovery efforts.

Emergency relief programs foster resilience, strengthen infrastructure, and prepare people and societies to better handle future disasters and challenges.

Our emergency relief programs brought immediate care and aid to people in **Bangladesh, Nigeria, Lebanon, Yemen, Sri Lanka, Afghanistan, Palestine, Sudan, Syria,** and Syrian refugees in **Turkiye.**

GAZA

A HUMANITARIAN EMERGENCY

In October 2023, Gaza faced an unprecedented crisis. Nearly 1.9 million people in the region have been internally displaced, of which nearly 80% are living in makeshift shelters without adequate food, water, shelter, clothing or protection from the cold.

The official death toll has surpassed 46,000, including nearly 18,000 children, and more than 100,000 individuals wounded and 4,500 amputations. Humaniti responded immediately, delivering food,

medical aid, shelter, and clean water to those in desperate need. Through strong local partnerships, we've been able to adapt, scale, and sustain our efforts as conditions evolve.

Access to reliable healthcare should not be an impossible luxury, but it is for 50% of the world's population. Humaniti and our partners are strategizing unique solutions to maximize our impact on populations struggling without healthcare.

Mobile clinics

Providing critical medical services to remote regions

Child heart surgeries

Performing open heart surgeries and catheterization procedures for children with heart defects

Health centre and clinic expansions

Expanding space and capacity for critical medical care

RUTFs

Providing life-saving nutrition for malnourished mothers and babies

Digital healthcare support

Connecting patients in need to healthcare professionals via text messaging

Support for special needs

Providing therapies and funding operations to support people with disabilities and other unique challenges

Access to healthcare immediately improves lives by treating illnesses, reducing suffering, and preventing disease. It lowers mortality rates and boosts productivity.

Over time, it supports healthier communities, enhances child development, and prevents chronic conditions.

With reliable healthcare, people live longer, pursue education and work, and break cycles of poverty and poor health.

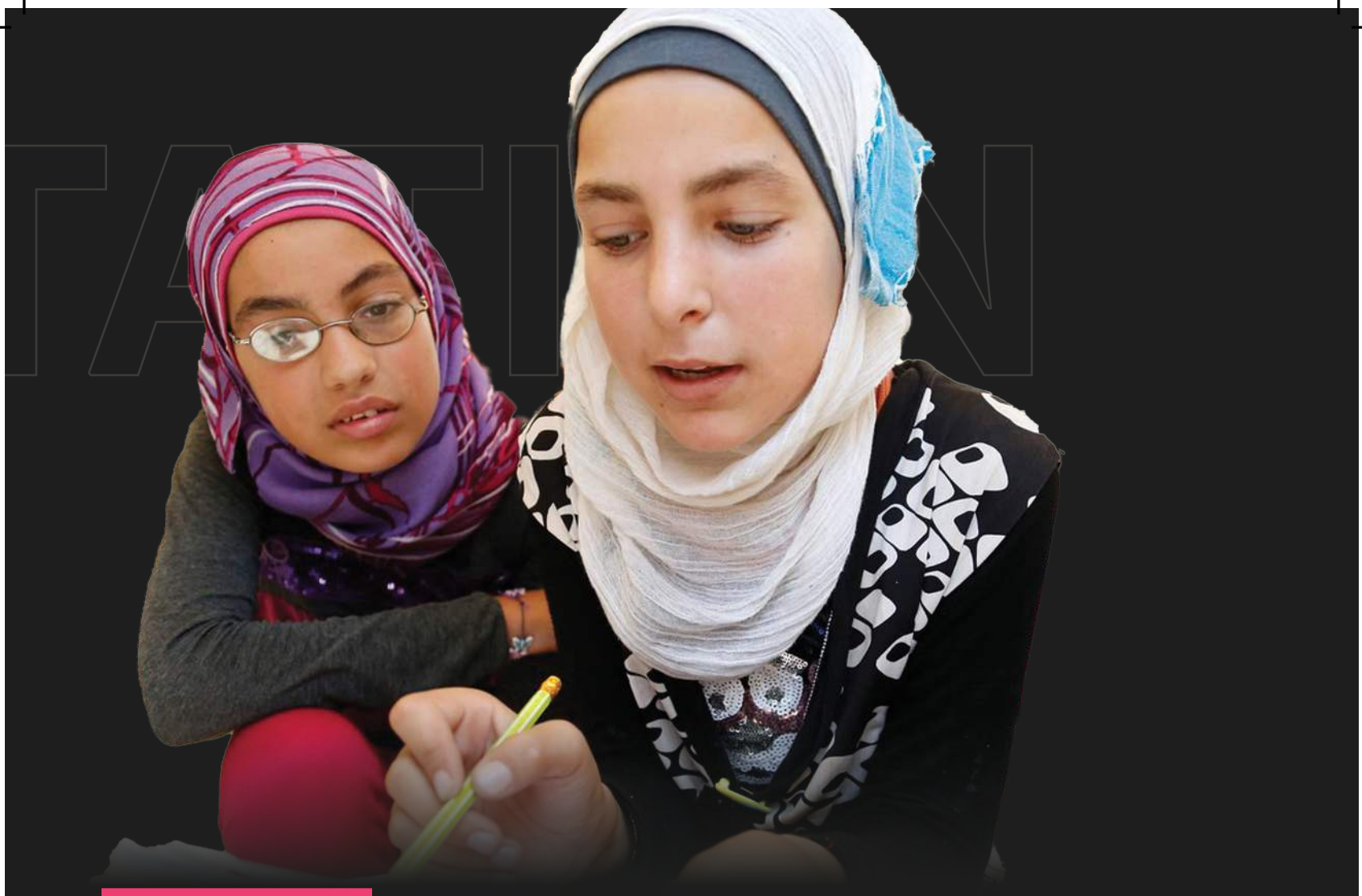

4,767 children

150M+ orphans are living without a guardian or basic necessities, and are in constant danger of exploitation, malnutrition and disease. Humaniti and our partners are approaching this dire need from multiple angles so that one day we can live in a world where no child is left behind.

Providing 24/7 support for up to a year or more

Prioritizing orphaned children with urgent aid including food, water and medical care

HOW SUPPORT FOR ORPHANS CHANGES LIVES

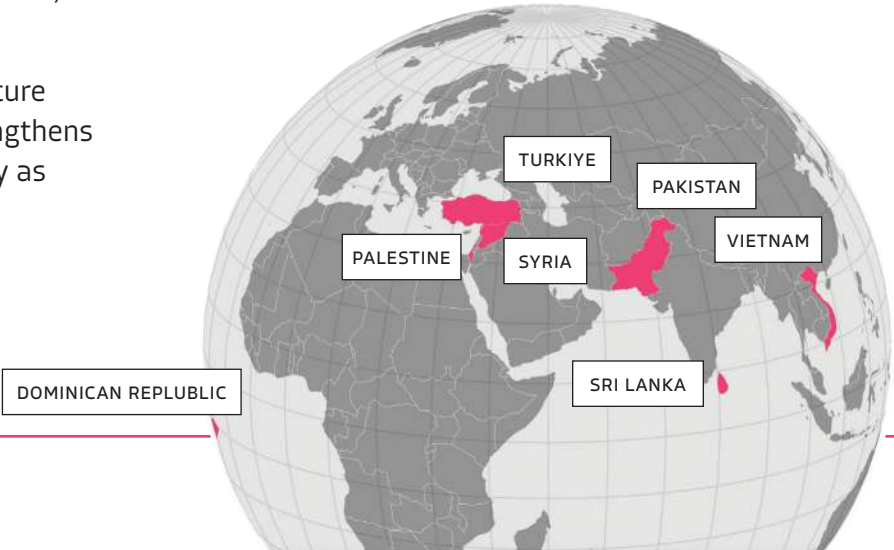
Caring for orphans transforms the most vulnerable young lives by giving them love, stability, and opportunities for a brighter future.

Excitement was in the air as children returned to brightly painted classrooms in newly refurbished schools across Northern Syria.


